

## The Kiplings of Mickleton

Kipling household 22 in the 1911 census at Counden, Durham was headed by miner Charles Kipling. Charles was the grandson of Charles Kipling, born in Mickleton in Romaldkirk parish.

Charles snr. was the son of the John Kipling ('of Lunedale') who married a Mary Pearson ('of Kirkby Stephen') at Romaldkirk in May 1812.

Who was John Kipling snr? The most likely candidate is the John Kipling born in 1782 of the Middleton-in Teesdale tree, a great-great grandson of John Kipling of Thatch Lea Farm (John, John, Charles, John of Thatch Lea), in turn likely a scion of the Kiplings of Newhouses. John of Mickleton's father was 'of Lunedale' when he died in 1834 (Mickleton lies at the end of Lunedale).

Charles snr later moved, first to Coxhoe then to Counden
