She beat over the sand and became leaky.—The Cinderella, Kipling, of and from Sunderland, for London, laden with coals, was assisted into our roads by a fishing boat and beachmen, this morning, in a leaky condition, having struck upon Sherringham Shoal about half-past ten last night. A steamer has been sent to her assistance.

BRITISH VESSELS LOST IN A GALE.

THOUSANDS WATCH THRILLING RESCUE.

Thousands of visitors at Redcar witnessed a thrilling rescue on Thursday of 20 shipwrecked men by a local lifeboat. In a very rough sea the large West Hartlepool vessel Teesdale foundered, and two men—Nathan Kipling, third engineer, of West Hartlepool, and W. Frome, stoker, of Plymouth—were drowned.

The remaining twenty men of the crew took to their boats, and after eight hours' terrible experience in the gale were rescued by the Redcar lifeboat. Most of the firemen and sailors belong to Plymouth and the officers to ports on the north-east coast.

LOCAL STEAMER FOUNDERS.

Two of the Crew Drowned and 21 Saved.

The West Hartlepool steamer Teesdale, tonnage 4,500, was lost in the storm a few miles off Staithes, on the Cleveland coast, about 6 o'clock yesterday morning, after battling for 36 hours with the gale. Of the crew of 23, 21 were saved by means of the ship's small boats, and, after being tossed about for seven hours, they were picked up by the Redcar lifeboat Fi Fi and Charles, which had rowed out nearly two miles to meet them on receiving warning that they were at the mercy of the waves. Splendid work was done by the lifeboat men and the skipper of the Teesdale, Captain T. M. Hill, of West Hartlepool.

The Teesdale was bound from the south of England for the Tees, and had been in difficulties since Tuesday night.

The two members of the crew drowned are third engineer Kipling, of Hartlepool, and a fireman named Frayne, of Plymouth, who both lost their lives in jumping from the sinking steamer towards the two small boats. Every effort was made to rescue them, but they disappeared under the big waves and were never seen again.

The Teesdale was owned by Messrs Ropner and Co.

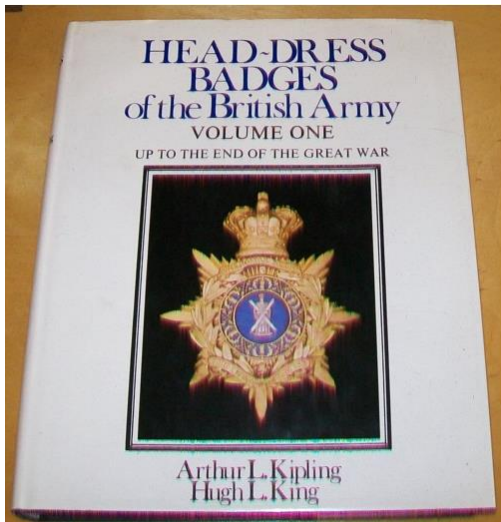
