The Kiplings of Tyneside

Quite a few Kiplings dwelt in Newcastle, Gateshead and the surrounding towns and villages in the 17th and 18th centuries. This note exhibits the records they left. Most of these Kiplings have not been associated with any particular 1911 family group.

This could be the same Robert who had children. Katheren (1617) and John (1619) at St Andrew, Newcastle. He was probably the son of William Kipling of Baldersdale who was "of newe castle" in the administration bond of his brother Mark in 1615.



In October 1624 of the same year, a Margret Kipling was buried at St Andrews on the 5^{th} and a Dorothie there on the 7^{th} (mother and daughter?).

Francis Kipling had children James (1623) and Ann (1626) baptised at St Nicholas and in 1621 and 1624, unnamed infant Kiplings were buried there. In 1631, his children Rebecca and Francis were baptised there (twins?) and two unnamed Kipling children were buried at St Nicholas on the 8th and the 14th of October (the same twins?). Another unnamed infant was buried there in December 1635.

Charles and Jane Kipling had a son John baptised at St Nicholas in 1635.

A Jane Koupling was buried at St Andrew in August 1650.

1652. Sept. 1. Robt. Kipling petitions that he took Lemmendon demesne from the Cou. Com. giving timely notice (at the request of the other tenants) to Cuth. Gabriel was vicar at Bywell St Peters between 1630-1649 (Fawcett Index). He was also listed as being of Gateshead in the Protestation returns of 1641-2, as was a John Kipling.

Gabriel was also witness to two wills in the parish of Brinkburn in 1622; George and Mary Collingwood. In the latter he is termed 'clark'.

Are the records below of the same Gabriel ("Peirson" could be 'Parson')? Being a parson in 1590 would make him a bit old to be fatherng a child in 1646 (although not imposible).


